Our Railroad Display Room is once again open the third Saturday monthly and for town events 10am-2pm. Volunteers are asked to call 530-235-0929 to volunteer during a month. Our Depot had a station ridership of 4879 with ticket revenues of \$315,550 for 2010 and is the only AMTRAK Siskiyou County stop. AMTRAK has installed an assisted wheelchair apparatus. We have installed camera systems in the waiting room, Railroad Display Room and Museum room.

2011 EVENTS

May 7th National Train Day: the Railroad Display Room will be open 10am-4pm. Featured will be an exhibit on how railroads played a part in the WWII effort. Highlighted will be the WWII Canteen of North Platte, Nebraska. The townspeople welcomed every troop train, day and night, at the UP station and yard.


